The Banding Coalition of the Americas and Dauphin Island Bird Sanctuaries have teamed up to present this spring banding event.

## Experience bird banding up close!

Federally-licensed banders will measure and band wild birds on site. Some birds may be presented for guests to see and photograph while BCA volunteers share species details and answer questions. All birds are safely released.

The banding event will be held across from the Goat Tree Reserve (on the corner of Cadillac Avenue and Grant Street on Dauphin Island. )

There is no entry fee to Dauphin Island, and the event is free, but donations to both organizations are welcome.

**What to bring:** a folding chair, bug repellent, water to drink, sunscreen, rain gear (if needed), and camera!

## Free parking and rest area at Cadillac Square

After parking, follow signs on foot: cross Bienville and walk a block north on Grant St.
